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## **Board of Directors' Meeting**

The North Collin Special Utility District ("NCSUD" or "District") Board of Directors will hold a Board of Directors' meeting on Thursday, January 15, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. The meeting will be held at NCSUD office at 2333 Sam Rayburn Hwy., Melissa, TX 75454. This meeting will be held in accordance with the following:

### **Agenda**

1. Call to order and Roll Call.
2. Hear public comments. (The NCSUD Board will hear public comments for items not listed on the agenda, but any discussion shall be limited to the item being placed on a future agenda for further consideration or, if appropriate, direct the speaker to District staff for more information. Limit individual comments to three minutes with a maximum of fifteen minutes total for public comments.)

9. Discuss and take appropriate action regarding a Non-Standard Service Contract by and between NCSUD and OPP-Colmena, LP, for Colmena Ranch being single-family residential, multi-family, mixed-use, and commercial development on approx. 2,450 acres at Weston Road and CR 205 in McKinney, Texas.
